The First Division Monument – Washington D.C.

The monument was conceived by the Society of the First Division to honor the valiant efforts of the soldiers who fought in World War I. Since the names of those killed-in-action in WW II, Vietnam, and Desert Storm were added to the Monument. HUEBNER SCHOLARSHIPS

Huebner Scholarships, named for Lieutenant General Clarence L. Huebner, who commanded the Big Red One during World War II, are competitive scholarships for children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of former members of the Division as well as children of active-duty 1st Infantry Division soldiers. Each scholarship award is currently for up to \$15,000 payable to the school in four annual installments of not more than \$3,750 per year.
